

Benefits of Immersion



Studies covering 6 states and 37 districts have found that compared with students in English-only classrooms, students in immersion programs have higher test scores, better attendance, fewer behavioral problems, and better class participation.

ATTENTION

Immersion requires more focus in the classroom setting. Students develop a "clearer attention signal" and more efficient learning.



COGNITION

Language students use higher order cognitive strategies in everyday learning, leading to increased brain matter and mental capacity.





SELF ESTEEM

Language students have a significantly higher self-concept than non-language students, a benefit that reaches across socio-economic and ethnic backgrounds.



SOCIAL SKILLS

Immersion encourages seeing the world from another's perspective. Multilingual students develop better interpersonal understanding.



In our increasing multiethnic and multicultural global society, multilingual students have unique insight and cultural competency because of their immersion education.



CAREER

Multilingual students have a distinct advantage in the workforce. They enhance our economic competitiveness abroad, and maintain our political and security interests.






We ARE Kansas City

ACADÉMIE LAFAYETTE STUDENT BODY


We are not a neighborhood school. We are a school for all of the students of the Kansas City Missouri Public School boundaries.
