

## MYP Scores and OLA Conversion Chart

### Criterion Achievement Levels

<b>Sum of scores in all 4 criteria</b>	<b>20/32</b>

Once criterion scores are determined for each of the four criteria, the gradebook automatically calculates the student's Overall Level of Achievement (OLA) score using this scale:

OLA	1	2	3	4	5	6	7
Sum of criteria	1-5	6-9	10-14	15-18	19-23	24-27	28-32

These descriptions distinguish differences between the levels of achievement.

28-32	<b>7</b>	Produces <b>high-quality, frequently innovative</b> work. Communicates <b>comprehensive, nuanced</b> understanding of concepts and contexts. <b>Consistently</b> demonstrates <b>sophisticated</b> critical and creative thinking. <b>Frequently transfers</b> knowledge and skills with <b>independence and expertise</b> in a <b>variety of complex</b> classroom and <b>real-world situations</b> .
24-27	<b>6</b>	Produces <b>high-quality, occasionally innovative</b> work. Communicates <b>extensive</b> understanding of concepts and contexts. Demonstrates critical and creative thinking, <b>frequently with sophistication</b> . Uses knowledge and skills in <b>familiar and unfamiliar</b> classroom and real-world situations, often with independence.
19-23	<b>5</b>	Produces <b>generally high-quality</b> work. Communicates <b>secure</b> understanding of concepts and contexts. Demonstrates <b>critical</b> and creative thinking, <b>sometimes with sophistication</b> . Uses knowledge and skills in familiar classroom and real-world situations, <b>and, with support, some unfamiliar</b> real-world situations.
15-18	<b>4</b>	Produces <b>good</b> quality work. Communicates <b>basic</b> understanding of most concepts and contexts with <b>few misunderstandings</b> and <b>minor gaps</b> . Often demonstrates <b>basic critical</b> and <b>creative</b> thinking. Uses knowledge and skills with <b>some flexibility in familiar</b> classroom situations, but <b>requires support in unfamiliar situations</b> .
10-14	<b>3</b>	Produces work of an <b>acceptable</b> quality. Communicates <b>basic</b> understanding of many concepts and contexts, with <b>occasionally significant misunderstandings or gaps</b> . <b>Begins</b> to demonstrate <b>some basic critical</b> and <b>creative</b> thinking. Is <b>often inflexible</b> in the use of knowledge and skills, <b>requiring support</b> even in familiar classroom situations
6-9	<b>2</b>	Produces work of <b>limited</b> quality. <b>Expresses misunderstandings</b> or <b>significant gaps</b> in understanding for many concepts and contexts. <b>Infrequently</b> demonstrates critical or creative thinking. <b>Generally inflexible</b> in the use of knowledge and skills, <b>infrequently applying</b> knowledge and skills.

1-5	<b>1</b>	Produces work of <b>very limited</b> quality. Conveys <b>many significant misunderstandings</b> or <b>lacks</b> understanding of most concepts and skills. <b>Very rarely</b> demonstrates critical or creative thinking. <b>Very inflexible, rarely</b> using knowledge or skills.
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## Semester Scores and Letter Grade Conversion

This conversion chart shows how Académie Lafayette determines letter grades when figuring GPAs on a 4.0 scale for the MYP. GPA is available on a transcript.

## Semester Scores and Letter Grade Conversion

Diploma Programme semester grades are determined by the student's achievement towards DP assessment criteria that are subject specific. The Overall Level of Achievement (OLA) uses the 7 point scale, like in the MYP.

The chart below describes the traditional letter grade conversion that is used at ALIHS when determining GPA and processing transcripts.
